New Things

Isaiah 43:19: Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert.

Defining new
according to
the Greek
and Hebrew

- **Hebrew/ Greek for New/ Newness**
- The main Greek word for "new" is **kainos** (G2537), which denotes a qualitative newness, while **neos** (G3501) signifies a temporal newness or youth. For "newness" in the sense of a state or renewal, the Greek is **kainotes** (G2538) or **anakainosis** (G342). In Hebrew, the word is **chadash** or **chadath** (H2323), often translating to "new" or "renew".



Greek Words

- **Kainos (G2537)**: New in quality, different in nature, fresh, or unused. It implies a radical change, such as in the "New Covenant".
- **Neos (G3501)**: New in time, more recent, or young. It can refer to something like "new wine" or "newly made".
- **Kainotes (G2538)**: "Newness," referring to a new state of being or existence, often used in the context of a divinely-wrought transition, as in "newness of life" (Romans 6:4) or "newness of the Spirit" (Romans 7:6).
- **Anakainosis (G342)**: "Renewal" or "renovation," a complete change for the better, like the renewing of the mind (Romans 12:2) or the work of the Holy Spirit (Titus 3:5).
- Hebrew word
- **Chadash / Chadath (H2323)**: "To renew" or "to restore." It is used to speak of a new covenant, or new materials for the temple, emphasizing a fresh start or renewal.



The Blood of Jesus

Walking in the Newness of Life

- Sin made us unqualified to walk in the newness of life. Romans 3:23 For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God.
- [Romans 6:4](#)
- Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.
- [Romans 7:6](#)
- But now we are delivered from the law, that being dead wherein we were held; that we should serve in newness of spirit, and not in the oldness of the letter.

2 Corinthians 5:17


Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a **new** creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become **new**.

You are a new creature


Old things have passed away



gotten him the victory.




Revelation 5:9
