This Syllabus guides you through the course the HOLY SPIRIT inspired us to develop to teach individuals:

- 1. First and foremost, <u>HOW to experience TRANSFORMATION and become a TRUE DISCIPLE</u> <u>and FOLLOWER of JESUS CHRIST</u> based on the NT Discipleship Pattern modeled by JESUS CHRIST during His Earthly ministry.
 - a. It is <u>primarily the writings of Paul, the Apostle</u>, that <u>provide the Scriptural instructions</u> that teach individuals "HOW-TO" <u>WALK</u> as a <u>TRUE</u> Follower of JESUS CHRIST.
 - b. JESUS CHRIST, <u>AFTER</u> His resurrection and <u>accession</u>, exclusively called Paul and sent him to <u>PREACH</u> and <u>TEACH</u> the GENTILES, KINGS, and JEWS "<u>HOW-TO</u>" be Followers and Disciples of Himself! (*Acts 1:1-2, 9:1-18; Gal. 1:1-12*)
- 2. Equally important, this course <u>teaches individuals HOW to PERFORM MINISTRY</u> based on this NT Discipleship Pattern. (*Eph. 4:11-16; 1 Cor. 12; Rom. 12*)

The primary purpose of this course is to enable individuals to become TRUE Disciples who <u>EXPERIENCE</u> the <u>TRANSFORMATION</u> into being new creatures in JESUS CHRIST. (2 Cor. 5:17)

It helps individuals obtain what they have been PURSUING but <u>FAILING to OBTAIN through MERE</u> <u>ATTENDANCE and MEMBERSHIP in "Religious Organized Christian Organizations!</u>"

This course <u>ANSWERS the QUESTION</u>, "What does being a TRUE Disciple of JESUS CHRIST "<u>LOOK</u> <u>LIKE</u>?"

The HOLY GHOST revealed that one <u>MUST</u> personally and intentionally <u>READ</u> and <u>STUDY</u> the NT Scriptures JESUS gave through <u>His NT Apostles</u>. (*Acts 1:1-2, 1 Pet. 2:1-2; 2 Pet. 1:5-15; 2 Tim. 2:15*)

READING and STUDYING the Holy Scriptures <u>is the ONLY WAY to EXPERIENCE the</u> <u>TRANSFORMATION</u> and <u>SALVATION</u> that comes with the new life in the Kingdom of GOD and Heaven that JESUS CHRIST came to give to those who would follow Him as His Disciples. (1 Pet. 2:2; St. Matt. 4:17, 16:24-28; St. John 10:9-10; Rom. 12:1-2)

The textbook for this course is "<u>Paul, The Moses of the New Testament Church</u>," written by Apostle Kelvin Franklin. This book reveals that <u>Paul was the "Moses-like figure"</u> sent by Our Heavenly Father and JESUS CHRIST to <u>PROVIDE the COMMANDMENTS and LAWS</u> needed to teach NT individuals "HOW-TO" be True Disciples and Followers of JESUS CHRIST!





This **book** contains **more than 400** Scripture passages, so one's understanding will be rooted in the WORD of GOD sent by JESUS to guide His Bride, the Church! (*Gal 1:1-12; Rom. 1:1; 1 Cor. 1:1; 2 Cor. 1:1; Eph. 1:1; Col. 1:1; 1 Tim. 1:1; Tit. 1:1*)

This course will **guide you through the Holy Scriptures** and **teach you to READ and STUDY** the <u>Commandments</u> that JESUS CHRIST sent by the HOLY GHOST through His Apostles for His Church. (*Acts 1:1-2*)

Enjoy your journey to new revelations and understandings that reveal the **mystery of Discipleship that was lost and replaced with the modern concepts of membership and philosophy** by organized religious institutions that masquerade as "the Church!" Come achieve the growth meant for all followers after rebirth into the Kingdom of Heaven. (*Col. 2:8-17; St. John 3:1-7; 1 Peter 2:1-2; 2 Peter 1:5-11*)

Please remember that this course is <u>designed for BOTH SELF-STUDY</u> and <u>GROUP STUDIES</u>. This course rightly places the <u>responsibility on the individual</u> as purposed by JESUS CHRIST under the New Covenant in His blood. It directly shifts the responsibility for one's growth from religious leaders <u>to individuals</u>.

We encourage you to be a faithful student who READS and STUDIES to EXPERIENCE TRANSFORMATION! (St. Matt. 4:4, 6:11; 2 Tim. 2:15)

This course answers the <u>question of what one should do once an individual decides to follow JESUS</u> <u>CHRIST</u>. It provides the roadmap and the Scriptural instructions that individuals can follow that will lead to SPIRITUAL GROWTH, TRANSFORMATION, and maturity as commanded by our LORD JESUS CHRIST! (*Heb. 5:11-14, 6:1-6*)

Syllabus – Learn How to be a True Disciple / Learn How to Perform Ministry Based on NT Discipleship Pattern (*By Apostle Kelvin Godfrey and Ramona Franklin*)



1. Introduction

Hello, my name is **Kelvin Franklin**, and the LORD called me to be a minister of the Gospel and an Apostle of JESUS CHRIST. I am joined in ministry by my wife, **Ramona Franklin**. Together, we lead the **New Testament (NT) Church Movement Ministry**.

Welcome to our (NT) Church Movement Ministry's Training Seminar to equip individuals first to become transformed into disciples and secondarily to minister Discipleship to others based on the NT Church Discipleship Pattern contained in the Holy Scriptures.

The genesis of this course was **<u>FIVE</u>** basic questions that were in my Heart that I sat out to answer from the earliest days of my youth:

- 1. What is <u>DISCIPLESHIP</u>, and what <u>DOES IT LOOK LIKE</u>?
- 2. How do I <u>GROW</u> and <u>TRANSFORM</u> into a disciple to experience peace and find my purpose?
- 3. How do I WALK as a Disciple of JESUS CHRIST and PLEASE our Heavenly FATHER?
- 4. What does MINISTRY LOOK LIKE based on the NT Discipleship model in the Holy Scriptures?
- 5. How do I <u>TEACH INDIVIDUALS</u> who accept JESUS CHRIST "<u>HOW-TO</u>" follow Him and also be <u>TRANSFORMED</u> into His Disciples?

The **HOLY SPIRIT** helped me to understand that the **Modern Organized Church** replaced **Discipleship** with **Membership** and **Philosophy** shortly after the original Apostles passed away. This revelation started coming to me during the writings of my book, **Paul, The Moses of the New Testament Church**, which is the foundation for this course.

This course represents the sum of the revelations the HOLY GHOST gave me to write to restore the teaching of Discipleship to the Body of JESUS CHRIST!

2. Purpose

The **purpose** of this course is to <u>HELP YOU</u> become <u>TRANSFORMED</u> into a <u>TRUE Follower</u> and <u>Disciple</u> of <u>JESUS CHRIST</u>. We aim to move many from the <u>modern practice</u> of <u>following religion</u> to the Scriptural **Pattern** of <u>actively pursuing Discipleship</u> in <u>JESUS CHRIST</u>!

This course provides the <u>Holy Scriptures</u> that **enable one** to be **TRULY REBORN and <u>TRANSFORMED</u> to a new life** in **JESUS CHRIST**! This course provides a **SYSTEMATIC TEACHING** and **JOURNEY** through the **NT Scriptures** given by **JESUS CHRIST** through <u>Paul</u> and the **other Apostles**. The **Apostle's writing** provides the "HOW-TO" INSTRUCTIONS on <u>WALKING</u> with JESUS CHRIST.

- This course defines the NT Church. It re-establishes the Holy Scriptures' definition that <u>INDIVIDUALS</u> are "<u>The CHURCH</u>," that <u>JESUS CHRIST</u> is our <u>RABBI</u> (<u>TEACHER</u>), and those who choose to FOLLOW HIM are called to <u>BECOME His STUDENTS</u> (<u>DISCIPLES</u>).
- 2) This course aims to **prepare individuals** to become <u>**TRUE Disciples of JESUS CHRIST**</u>, <u>**minister**</u> <u>**the Gospel**</u>, and <u>**teach OTHERS who accept JESUS CHRIST how to BECOME His TRUE**</u> <u>**DISCIPLES ALSO**.</u>
 - a) JESUS instructed those Jews who **believed on Him** that "<u>IF</u>" they would <u>CONTINUE</u> in His WORD, then would they be His Disciples <u>INDEED</u>, and they would <u>KNOW</u> the <u>TRUTH</u>, and the <u>TRUTH</u> would <u>MAKE THEM FREE</u>! (*St. John 8:30-32*)





- 3) This course is built around the <u>need</u> for those who would <u>follow</u> JESUS CHRIST to become "STUDENTS (DISCIPLES) who READ and STUDY the Holy Scriptures" so they might know "HOW TO" WALK with JESUS and PLEASE our Heavenly FATHER!
- 4) This course is **designed** for **SELF-STUDY**, **GROUP STUDY**, and **VIRTUAL STUDIES**, focusing on bringing about **ONE'S TRANSFORMATION**!

The goal is for individuals to possess the <u>KNOWLEDGE</u> and <u>FAITH</u> to be the <u>TRUE CHURCH</u>, the <u>LIVING MEMBERS of the BODY of JESUS CHRIST</u>. (1 Cor. 12; 12-31)

This course is **designed** so individuals can <u>obtain the KNOWLEDGE of the TRUTH</u>, be <u>ASSURED of</u> <u>THEIR SALVATION</u>, and be <u>PREPARED for the LORD's RETURN and the coming FINAL</u> <u>JUDGMENT</u>!

3. Why the Need to Study Discipleship?

First and foremost, this study aims to enable individuals to **experience the TRANSFORMATION that JESUS' Disciples and the early Church experienced**!

TRUE <u>TRANSFORMATION</u> can only be experienced when those who were "<u>BORN AGAIN</u>" as <u>BABES</u> into the Kingdom of Heaven begin to <u>READ and STUDY the SINCERE MILK of the WORD</u>, the NT Writings of the Apostles. (St. John 3:1-8; 2 Peter 2:1-2)

Therefore, JESUS <u>sent his COMMANDMENTS</u> through his Apostles to <u>EQUIP</u> His <u>BODY;</u> the <u>EKKLESIA</u> (the <u>CHURCH</u>) – His <u>FOLLOWERS</u> – His <u>DISCIPLES</u>! (St. Matt. 28:18-20; Eph. 4:11-16)

Many have attempted to experience TRANSFORMATION through <u>ritualistic attendance</u>, <u>participation</u>, and <u>dedication</u> to the "Organized Church!"

The "Organized Church" is the name the HOLY SPIRIT gave me for the Organized Christian Religion that was first <u>established</u> by <u>the Roman Government</u> (the Roman Catholic Church) in 325 A.D.!

Much of what the Roman Government established <u>continues</u> today throughout the **Catholic** and **Protestant denominations throughout the world**.

Today's Protestant Denominations were **derived from the governmental "Catholic" church organization** and still follow much of the **perversions** that the **Roman Government designed** in their **religious organization**, which they called "**Christianity**!"

The **Roman Government** established its **governmental Church** as a replacement for the **TRUE Church**, the **Followers** and **Disciples** of **JESUS CHRIST**! The **Roman Government** legalized the **Christian Religion** and **set up** its **foundational dogma**, which was rooted in **Platonic Thinking** (the Greek Philosophers like Plato, **Aristotle**, and **Socrates**), **Roman culture**, and the <u>Holy Scriptures</u> (*albeit a perverted form*).

Yet, interestingly, **the Roman Government** perverted much, if not all, of the essential teachings of the Holy Scriptures regarding JESUS CHRIST and the COMMANDMENTS He gave to the Apostles that were contained in their early writings!

See some of these perversions in the following table.

Additionally, the Roman Government made Latin the language of its writings for its governmental church and outlawed reading the Holy Scriptures. However, Latin is <u>NOT</u> a spoken language and would be unknown (hidden) to everyday people. This perversion of hiding individuals' access to the Holy Scriptures contradicts JESUS' example because He came to heal and deliver the poor and brokenhearted and to set the captives free. JESUS spoke directly to the people! The Apostles wrote directly to the Disciples in Greek, the everyday language! The Roman Government, however, <u>HID</u> the TRUTH, the Holy Scriptures, and gave us the <u>MODERN CHRISTIAN RELIGION</u> based on RITUALS, PHILOSOPHY, PAGAN GODS, PAGAN PRACTICES, and IDOLATRY in ITS PLACE! (*St. Luke 4:18-19*)

NOTE: The NT Church and the Organized Church discussion the LORD gave me is NOT about the NATURAL, but the SPIRITUAL! The name "NT Church" focuses on individuals becoming "The CHURCH" and MEMBERS of the BODY and the BRIDE of JESUS CHRIST as written in the Holy Scriptures. The name "Organized Church" focuses on the fact that Rome created the <u>Religious</u> Roman Catholic Church and did everything <u>SPIRITUALLY</u> <u>CONTRARY</u> to the Holy Scriptures. As a <u>result</u>, many now <u>FOLLOW RELIGION</u> and <u>NOT</u> JESUS CHRIST!

HOWEVER, from the NATURAL STANDPOINT, for this discussion:

- It does <u>NOT MATTER</u> if <u>YOU/WE</u> meet in <u>BUILDINGS</u> or <u>HOMES</u>!
- It does <u>NOT MATTER</u> if <u>YOU/WE</u> are <u>LEGALLY ORGANIZED</u> or <u>UNORGANIZED</u>!

WHAT <u>MATTERS <mark>SPIRITUALLY</mark> is <u>WHETHER</u> YOU/WE are <u>FOLLOWING</u> the Pattern of Discipleship of the early CHURCH (individual followers of JESUS CHRIST) as recorded in the Holy Scriptures!</u>

This Discipleship training is <u>DESIGNED</u> to <u>EQUIP</u> INDIVIDUALS with the SCRIPTURAL KNOWLEDGE they need to LIVE as the SPIRITUAL CHURCH of JESUS CHRIST! (*Eph. 4:11-16*)

This course will help YOU <u>READ</u> and <u>STUDY</u> the <u>HOLY SCRIPTURES</u> so <u>YOU</u> can KNOW WHO YOU ARE as a BORN AGAIN FOLLOWER and <u>BECOME</u> <u>TRANSFORMED</u> back into the <u>IMAGE</u> and <u>LIKENESS</u> of the GODHEAD (the FATHER, SON, and HOLY GHOST)! (*St. John 3:1-7; 2 Tim. 2:15; Rom. 12:1-2; Gal. 4:19*)





4. What Does Being a TRUE Disciple of JESUS "LOOK LIKE?"

The course guides you to search the Holy Scriptures to understand what being a **TRUE Follower** and **Disciples** of **JESUS CHRIST** <u>actually</u> "LOOKS LIKE!" <u>Did you know</u> that **JESUS** commanded those who would seek Him to "<u>SEARCH the scriptures</u>; for in them **YE THINK YE HAVE ETERNAL LIFE**: and **THEY are THEY which TESTIFY of ME**?" (*St. John. 5:29*)

Today, many individuals think of the "<u>Church</u>" ONLY as a <u>religious organization</u>, <u>religious leaders</u>, or <u>buildings (commonly called "churches"</u>) where individuals are required <u>to attend to worship GOD</u>! Many seek to be faithful members of these religious organizations and focus on remaining in "good standings" with them because they were taught this is the way of pleasing GOD.

During the **COVID Pandemic** (*from approx. 2020-2022*), many religious organizations were ordered to shut their doors to help prevent the spread of the deadly disease. I think it was during this time that many routine worshipers and members experienced the following over those two years:

- 1) They felt lost because their primary identity as a "<u>Christian</u>" was tied to weekly gatherings in places commonly known as "Churches!"
- 2) They experienced isolation, living ALONE, becoming sick ALONE, or dying ALONE!
- 3) They realized they did <u>NOT</u> know how to <u>READ</u> and <u>STUDY</u> the Holy Scriptures ALONE!
- 4) They realized they did <u>NOT</u> know "<u>HOW-TO</u>" <u>WALK</u> with JESUS CHRIST <u>ALONE</u> as His <u>MATURE</u> Followers and Disciples!

This course teaches that **Discipleship** is **based** on **following JESUS CHRIST** and <u>NOT</u> on **buildings** or **members in religious organizations**. Do you <u>NOT</u> remember how JESUS did <u>NOT</u> spend most of His time **at the Temple in Jerusalem**, which GOD had built as a tabernacle for His SPIRIT on Earth? JESUS even prophesied about the Temple's coming destruction early in His ministry. (*St. John 2:13-21*)

TRUE Discipleship is when one is **EDUCATED in the WRITINGS of the APOSTLES**, whom **JESUS CHRIST** sent to **TEACH** those who would come afterward and believe in Him. The Apostles wrote most of their NT writings (NT Scriptures) in **Greek**. **Greek** was the universal language of that day! **JESUS commanded** His **Apostles** to **go and teach the Gospel** throughout the WORLD. **JESUS** also **commanded His Apostles** to **TEACH** those who **REPENTED** and **BELIEVED IN HIM "HOW-TO" FOLLOW** and **PLEASE HIM**! **Discipleship** is the **PROCESS** of **LEARNING to FOLLOW** the **COMMANDMENTS** JESUS **SENT** by the **hands of His Apostles**. (*St. Matt.* 28:18-20, Acts 1:1-2)

TRUE Discipleship is NOT about MEMBERSHIP in a RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION! TRUE Discipleship is about READING and STUDYING the NT writings of the New Covenant so we might know "HOW WE OUGHT to WALK and PLEASE the FATHER and JESUS!" (Acts 1:1-2; 1 Thess. 4:1-3)

TRUE Discipleship is about HOW WE LIVE EVERY MOMENT OF EVERY DAY FOR THE REST OF OUR LIVES.

TRUE Discipleship is when we **PURGE** out "**EVERY EVIL THOUGHT**" (*2 Cor. 10:3-5*) and **REPLACE** them with "**ALL GOOD THOUGHTS**" (*Gen. 6:5-6*) based on the **TRANSFORMATION** that takes place when we **RENEW** our **MINDS** (*Rom. 12:1-2*) by **WASHING** our **MIND** in the **WORD of GOD** that **JESUS CHRIST SENT** to **CLEANSE His BRIDE**, the **CHURCH**, the **MEMBERS of His BODY**! (*Eph 5:25-32*)





This course will teach and demonstrate what it "LOOKS LIKE" to be a TRUE Disciple of JESUS CHRIST in today's world!

5. NT Church Movement Ministry Website

In 2014, the HOLY GHOST revealed to me the NT Church Movement. The NT Church Movement was the announcement of a soon-coming movement that would be ushered in by the HOLY GHOST, that would cause many to <u>depart the false and misleading teachings of religious organizations</u> and return to the TRUE meaning and purpose of the NT Church and Discipleship in accordance with the Holy Scriptures.

Our ministry is **focused** on encouraging individuals to become <u>students of the Holy Scriptures</u> and <u>seek the</u> <u>leading of the HOLY SPIRIT</u>. Individuals should seek to be True Disciples through reading and studying the NT Commandments that JESUS CHRIST sent by His Apostles to guide His Body, His Bride, and the Church!

Acts 1:1-2

- 1. The former treatise have I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach,
- 2. UNTIL the day in which HE was <u>TAKEN UP</u>, <u>AFTER</u> that HE <u>THROUGH the HOLY GHOST</u> had <u>given</u> <u>COMMANDMENTS</u> unto the <u>APOSTLES</u> WHOM HE HAD <u>CHOSEN</u>:

1 Thessalonians 4:1-3

- 1. Furthermore then we BESEECH you, brethren, and EXHORT you by the LORD JESUS, that as ye HAVE RECEIVED of us <u>HOW YE OUGHT</u> to <u>WALK</u> and to <u>PLEASE</u> GOD, so ye would <u>abound more</u> and more.
- 2. For ye KNOW what COMMANDMENTS we GAVE YOU by the LORD JESUS.
- 3. For THIS is the WILL of GOD, even <u>YOUR</u> SANCTIFICATION, that ye should <u>ABSTAIN from</u> <u>FORNICATION</u>:
- 4. That every one of you should know HOW TO POSSESS HIS VESSELL in SANCTIFICATION and HONOUR;

I started building the NT Church Movement Ministry website in 2014. Ramona and I have been continuing the effort since our union to develop NT Discipleship training materials based on my 50 years of researching the *Book of the Holy Scriptures* (*The Bible*) and what the LORD has taught us in our coming together.

The book started with a revelation the HOLY GHOST gave Kelvin regarding Paul and Moses in April 2012 based on a simple question, "Have you ever compared Paul and Moses?" The HOLY GHOST revealed **twelve points of comparison between Paul and Moses** that revealed that JESUS chose Paul to be the **Moses-Like lawgiver to Disciples in the NT Church**. This book shares the **wisdom** and **understanding** the LORD revealed that provides a **comprehensive NT Disciple's Study and Training Resource** that is the foundation for this course.

7. Overview

This course provides comprehensive training on Discipleship to equip individuals to know "**HOW-TO**" follow JESUS CHRIST and PLEASE GOD as His TRUE Followers and Disciples. It strives to answer the question, "**What does being a Disciple of JESUS CHRIST look like today**?" It also helps to frame the discussion of "**What should ministry look like when one focuses on evangelizing individuals and teaching them to be disciples**?" Most importantly, our ministry seeks to **grow New Born babes in JESUS CHRIST into maturity Disciples** so they can stand alone and are **fully equipped to live daily on their own faith**. Just as JESUS trained His Apostles and Disciples and departed them to live alone, ministers are called to teach individuals to be disciples who are mature followers of JESUS CHRIST, able to teach others. (*Heb. 5:11-14*)

A. Main and Optional Sections

Please, do not be overwhelmed by the size of this Syllabus!

This Syllabus is designed to be comprehensive and divided into several teaching sections.

These sections are organized as follows:

- a) **Comprehensive Discipleship Training Outline** (*Main*): The central portion of the course is based on the book, *Paul, The Moses of the New Testament Church*. It contains ten (10) key topics comprehensively covering TRUE Discipleship in JESUS CHRIST
- b) Maturity Exam the Seven Doctrines of JESUS CHRIST (Optional): An optional section covering the seven (7) key focus areas of the Doctrines of JESUS CHRIST from Hebrews 6:1-2. I recommend a self-study of this section which starts with a pursuit of Perfection and Repentance and ends with a teaching on eternal judgment. It contains references to numerous scriptures under each of the seven topics.

- c) Other Key Discipleship Patterns to Study (*Optional*): This section links to online Discipleship books Kelvin wrote in the early 1990s. These books provide Scriptural teachings on subjects like Reading, Salvation, Baptism, Fasting, Gifts and Callings, Spiritual Warfare, and Marriage Fellowship. These are excellent reference materials to strengthen knowledge of crucial Discipleship Patterns.
- d) **Other NT Church Movement Study Charts** (*Optional*): This section provides links to Scriptural Charts on the NT Church Movement Ministry Blog site. These Charts were developed by Kelvin through the inspiration of the HOLY SPIRIT. They teach about the Three Discipleship Ages, provide a Scriptural Analysis of Salvation, outline a Discipleship Roadmap, reveal the NT Church Characteristics, and provide a study guide for the Book of Acts!

As we stated, this Syllabus was designed to provide you with **comprehensive Discipleship instruction!** You can **choose which areas you want to study**. It is designed to **last you throughout your Discipleship journey**. **So take your time and enjoy the journey!** May you **experience the TRANSFORMATION and strengthening of your faith** that I experienced in writing all these materials and developing this course!

B. Overall Learning Objectives

The following are the objectives that you will learn through this course. First, this course teaches how to look at and understand the Holy Scriptures **through the lens of focusing on walking with JESUS CHRIST** and **pleasing the Father**. This course teaches the **numerous important truths that JESUS CHRIST sent through His Apostles** to guide those who come after Him and be his Disciples. Additionally, this course will teach you the **following patterns of Discipleship contained throughout the Holy Scriptures**:

- 1. Understanding the Scriptural definition and meaning of "Church."
- 2. Describe the importance of living under a New Covenant
- 3. Explain that individuals are **called to be Disciples** and not members of organized religious institutions
- 4. Describe what Discipleship is according to the Holy Scriptures
- 5. Describe what Discipleship "looks like" and how to be an example that others can follow
- 6. Understand how to minister based on following the Discipleship Pattern in the Holy Scriptures
- 7. Explain the need to focus on walking with JESUS instead of gatherings and worship
- 8. Describe how the Disciple's Body is the NT Temple of the HOLY SPIRIT
- 9. Explain how JESUS fulfilled the Law and Destroyed the OT Temple Model of Worship
- 10. Explain how JESUS CHRIST sent COMMANDMENTS by the Apostles He chose through the HOLY GHOST to the NT Disciples
- 11. Explain the urgent **necessity that Disciples return to the original terminology of the Scriptures** written by the Apostles through the HOLY GHOST
- 12. Describe and explain the Seven (7) Doctrines of JESUS CHRIST and our Heavenly FATHER

C. Specific Learning Objectives

This section focuses on overarching truths regarding Discipleship that a minister should understand, follow, and be able to teach to others seeking to become disciples.

- 9. Describe and use the **Discipleship RoadMap**
- 10. Explain the Significance of the **focus on the name of JESUS** throughout the book of Acts and the other writings of the Apostles
- 11. Describe and explain the Characteristics of the NT Church in Acts
- 12. Explain the Significance of the LORD's supper and how to perform it with honor and reverence

D. Other Key Discipleship Principles

This section focuses on the fundamental truths that teach individuals **"HOW-TO" WALK daily** as Disciples of JESUS CHRIST. Individuals should know how to live these truths in their daily lives, in addition, to being able to teach others.

- 1. Explain the importance of <u>**READING**</u> and <u>**STUDYING**</u> the Holy Scriptures
- 2. Explain Salvation
- 3. Explain **<u>Baptism</u>** and understand how to perform a baptism
- 4. Explain **Fasting** and why one should fast today
- 5. Explain Gifts and Calling and how one should learn to WALK in their Gift
- 6. Spiritual Warfare and how to battle the forces of Satan and Darkness in one's WALK
- 7. Explain Marriage and Fellowship and their Significance to walking as a Disciple

8. Comprehensive Discipleship Training Outline (Main)

This section contains the **master study outline for this course**. My book, *Paul, The Moses of the New* <u>Testament Church</u>, is the source of these teachings. This book is an extended long conversational study that the LORD enabled me to write from my revelation of Paul and Moses in 2012. I wrote this book between 2018 and 2021. The knowledge contained in the book was gained through my more than fifty (50) years of reading, studying, teaching, and preaching the Holy Scriptures, starting at the age of four to five.

These revelations helped me see the Holy Scriptures through the lens of the FATHER, JESUS, and the HOLY GHOST and **replaced** the **Organized Churches' philosophical lens** that I had **previously been taught to see through**. In addition, much of the book's text is **recorded conversations I experienced with the HOLY SPIRIT** during my writing, recordings I would make on my iPhone and later have auto-transcribed.

It is crucial that you **take the time to read my book**, **study/search the Holy Scriptures**, and <mark>seek to hear the voice of the HOLY GHOST</mark> if you want to **TRULY** <u>understand how to live and teach Discipleship in</u> <u>JESUS CHRIST</u>!

We are now at the end of the section that is the main focus of this syllabus.

9. Maturity Exam – The Seven Doctrines of JESUS CHRIST (Optional)

This section is OPTIONAL but highly recommended.

This section reveals GOD's measure of MATURITY for the Followers and Disciples of JESUS CHRIST.

This section is based on *Hebrew. 5:11 through 6:6* that reveal the <u>SEVEN DOCTRINES of JESUS CHRIST</u>, which are also the <u>FIRST ORACLES of GOD</u>.

This section will further equip you to be prepared for the LORD's return and enhance your effectiveness as His Disciple and as a minister of the Gospel of JESUS CHRIST!

A. What are the 7 Principles of the Doctrines of JESUS CHRIST?

These are the Seven Principles of the Doctrines of JESUS CHRIST that are enumerated in Hebrews:

- 1. **Doctrine 1 Perfection** (run the race)
- 2. Doctrine 2 Repentance (from dead works)
- 3. Doctrine **3** Faith (impossible to please GOD without it)
- 4. Doctrine 4 Baptisms (of the water, HOLY GHOST, and WORD)
- 5. Doctrine 5 Laying on of Hands (Gifts & Callings)
- 6. Doctrine 6 Resurrection (of JESUS and those who trust in him)
- 7. Doctrine 7 Eternal Judgment (Preparing for JESUS's Return)

These **Doctrines of JESUS CHRIST** were taken directly from *Hebrews 6:1-2*. These Scriptures provide the TEST questions that GOD gave Paul to write and send to Disciples so they could <u>examine if they had become</u> <u>MATURE Disciples</u>. Or, had they <u>remained as BABES</u> who needed instructions in the NT Scriptures given by JESUS' Apostles so they could **GROW UP**?

KEEP IN MIND that the NT CHURCH was composed <mark>MAINLY</mark> of <mark>GENTILES</mark> who DID <u>NOT</u> HAVE <u>ACCESS to the OT WRITINGS</u>.

The <u>GENTILES</u> ONLY had the <u>WRITINGS of JESUS' APOSTLES</u> who wrote in <u>GREEK</u> so it could reach the <u>MILLIONS</u> of <u>GENTILES</u> who had become Disciples and FOLLOWERS of JESUS CHRIST!





JESUS JUDGED the Seven Churches of Asia concerning their <u>OBEDIENCE</u> to the COMMANDMENTS, LAWS, and Instructions He had sent primarily by Paul. It also includes the other apostles.

JESUS WARNED more of them to **REPENT** and **REMEMBER** to **DO** what they had <u>HEARD</u> and **RECEIVED** from His Apostles. (*Revelations 1-3*)

JESUS <u>COMMANDED SEVEN TIMES</u> that they should "<u>HAVE AN EAR</u> to <u>HEAR</u> <u>WHAT the</u> HOLY SPIRIT is <u>SAYING</u> to the <u>CHURCHES</u> (the INDIVIDUAL DISCIPLES)!"

B. Significance of the Book of Hebrews

Hebrews is one of the **MOST SIGNIFICANT** books in the **NT Writings**. Scholars now debate the authorship of *Hebrews*. It used to be commonly accepted that Paul was the writer. However, many scholars now do <u>NOT</u> attribute Hebrews to Paul because it does not match his typical writing style.

The truth is that *Hebrews* <u>DOES NOT</u> match **anyone's writing style** because I believe that <u>GOD is the</u> <u>AUTHOR!</u> Paul <u>merely</u> served to record GOD's WORDS for the edification (building up) of JESUS' Followers and Disciples!

Hebrews is a book that I believe was <u>given to Paul</u> by <u>GOD</u>, its <u>Author</u>. *Hebrews* is a book whose content was given to Paul by GOD. This book is:

- 1. The only book in the Holy Scriptures that begins with "GOD."
 - a) Paul's other 13 books begin with His name, "Paul."
- The only book that gives the lineage of Melchisedec (Heb. 5-7) (Genesis 14:17 Melchizedek, King of Salem – brought bread and wine, and he was the Priest of the most high GOD)
- 3. Tells the testimony of Enoch and other saints that were not previously known (Heb. 11)
- 4. Reveals that JESUS CHRIST came to perform the volume of the book written of Him (Heb 10:1-7) (*Psa. 40:6-7*)
- 5. **Reveals that it is <u>appointed</u> unto man, <u>once to die</u>; <u>after</u> that <u>judgment</u> (Heb. 9:27)**

C. Discipleship Maturity Graduations Question that one Should Answer

I believe the maturity exam will help answer the questions that every Follower of JESUS CHRIST should seek to answer:

- 1. What does it look like to walk and live as a TRUE Disciple and Follower of JESUS CHRIST (What does Discipleship look like?)
- 2. Are there specific areas of knowledge that JESUS and GOD expect a <u>mature Disciple</u> to know? (Did our Heavenly Father leave us graduation protocols?)





- 3. Did the requirement for Discipleship <u>change</u> since JESUS first called men to be His Disciples? (Should Discipleship today <u>look the same</u> in terms of <u>life</u>, <u>learning</u>, and <u>commitments</u> as seen by the original Disciples?)
- 4. Should those who seek to follow Christ earnestly read and study the Holy Scriptures so they will <u>KNOW HOW</u> to Walk with JESUS CHRIST today? (2 Tim 4:7)

I pray that you keep these questions in your mind throughout your life and the remainder of your Discipleship journey!

D. Scriptural Basis for the Maturity Questions

The outline for this study is based on *Hebrews 5:11-14* where Followers of JESUS are encouraged to <u>STUDY</u> the Holy Scriptures so they can become <u>SKILFUL</u> in the WORD of GOD!

It continues in *Hebrews 6:1-6* to enumerate the Doctrines of JESUS CHRIST. There were **Seven Key Discipleship Patterns** outlined in verses one and two. These form the basis for **GOD's MATURITY EXAM!**

Hebrews 5:11-14

- Of whom we have many things to say (of Melchisedec), and hard to be uttered, seeing ye are <u>dull of</u> <u>hearing</u>.
- 12. FOR when for the time <u>YE</u> <u>OUGHT</u> to be <u>TEACHERS</u>, ye have NEED that one <u>TEACH YOU</u> <u>AGAIN</u> which be the <u>FIRST PRINCIPLES of the ORACLES of GOD</u>; and are become such as have <u>NEED of MILK</u>, and <u>NOT</u> of STRONG MEAT.
- 13. For every one that useth <u>MILK</u> is <u>UNSKILFUL</u> in the WORD of RIGHTEOUSNESS: for he is a <u>BABE</u>.
- 14. But <u>STRONG MEAT</u> belongeth to them that are of <u>FULL AGE</u>, even those who by REASON of USE have their <u>SENSES EXERCISED</u> to <u>DISCERN</u> both GOOD and EVIL.

Hebrews 6:1-6

- 1. Therefore <u>LEAVING</u> the <u>PRINCIPLES of the DOCTRINE of CHRIST</u>, let us go on unto (1) <u>PERFECTION</u>; NOT LAYING AGAIN the FOUNDATION of (2) <u>REPENTANCE</u> from DEAD WORKS, and of (3) FAITH toward GOD,
- 2. Of the DOCTRINE of (4) **BAPTISMS**, and of (5) **LAYING on of HANDS**, and of (6) **RESURRECTION of the DEAD**, and of (7) **ETERNAL JUDGMENT**.
- 3. And this will we do, **IF** <u>GOD</u> permit.
- 4. For it is **IMPOSSIBLE** for those who were <u>ONCE ENLIGHTENED</u>, and have <u>TASTED</u> of the <u>HEAVENLY GIFTS</u>, and were made <u>PARTAKERS</u> of the <u>HOLY GHOST</u>,
- 5. And have <u>TASTED</u> the <u>GOOD WORD</u> of <u>GOD</u>, and the <u>POWERS</u> of the <u>WORLD to COME</u>,
- 6. IF THEY SHALL FALL AWAY, to <u>RENEW THEM AGAIN</u> unto <u>REPENTANCE</u>; seeing they <u>CRUCIFY</u> to <u>THEMSELVES</u> the <u>SON of GOD</u> AFRESH, and PUT <u>HIM</u> to an <u>OPEN</u> <u>SHAME</u>.

I encourage you to <u>**READ</u>** and <u>**STUDY**</u> these questions posed in the Scriptures above. Would you be able to answer these questions if GOD were to judge your understanding and your life? I pray that you will be able to do so after you complete this course.</u>





E. Table Study Outline

The following table contains the study outline for the Seven Doctrines of JESUS CHRIST. This study outline mirrors the principles of the **DOCTRINE of JESUS CHRIST** that was enumerated in *Hebrews 6:1-2*.

These **SEVEN DOCTRINES** start at the beginning with the need for **PERFECTION** and end with **ETERNAL JUDGEMENT**. One of the Doctrines that is taught the least is **ETERNAL JUDGEMENT**! We must teach Disciples about **ETERNAL JUDGMENT**, which helps them understand that they are <u>accountable</u> for all their actions and that they should <u>strive to GROW in the Knowledge of JESUS CHRIST</u> so they can have **FULL ASSURANCE of THEIR SALVATION**! (2 Peter 1:5-12)

12. Evangelism and The Making of TRUE Disciples

What does it look like when we start to make disciples in the same pattern observed in the Holy

Scriptures? These discussions are purposely designed to cause us to focus on the Holy Scriptures and not the philosophical teachings that have consumed the Organized Church since the death of the first Apostles and the establishment of the **Roman governmental church**.

Almost everything the **Roman Catholic Church** teaches is a **direct contradiction** and **perversion** of the Commandments that JESUS CHRIST sent by His Apostles. JESUS sent Commandments and Laws to His Apostles through the HOLY GHOST.

A. How do you walk as a True Disciple of JESUS CHRIST?

What does it "LOOK LIKE?" What does it "LOOK LIKE" to be a TRUE Disciples of JESUS CHRIST?

The Scriptural concept of Discipleship was lost after the 1st-century apostles passed away. As a result, we lost the meaning of Discipleship, which was replaced with membership in an institutional organized religion called Christianity. Christianity is built on the man-based doctrine that departed from the writings of Paul, whom JESUS sent to teach Discipleship to the Gentiles, Kings, and Jews!

- 1. **Possess a love and desire** for the <u>reading</u> and <u>studying</u> of the Holy Scriptures, which is **essential for** growth
- 2. **NT Disciples' bodies** are the **<u>NT Temples of the HOLY GHOST</u>** and JESUS CHRIST and the HEAVENLY FATHER
- 3. Understand that the HEART is defined as the <u>SUM</u> of the THOUGHTS of <u>ONE'S IMAGINATION</u>
- 4. NT Disciples <u>MUST FILL</u> their <u>MINDS</u> with <u>GOOD THOUGHTS</u> (from the READING and STUDYING of the HOLY SCRIPTURES, which strengthens ONES' FAITH)
- 5. NT Disciples **MUST ELIMINATE EVIL THOUGHTS**. In the days of NOAH, **EVERY**
 - IMAGINATION of man's <u>THOUGHTS</u> was <mark>ONLY</mark> EVIL CONTINUALLY
 - a. **EVERY THOUGHT being EVIL CONTINUALLY** is the **REASON** GOD **DESTROYED** the WORLD with a FLOOD
 - b. **GOD** had <u>LOST</u> the PURPOSE for which He had CREATED MAN, which was to LOVE HIM with "ALL" HIS HEART, SOUL, MIND, and STRENGTH."
- 6. MUST <u>NOT</u> DEFILE their BODIES with EVIL THOUGHTS, which will cause the HOLY GHOST to <u>NOT</u> DWELL in the <u>TEMPLE of THEIR BODY</u>
- 7. MUST <u>POSSESS</u> <u>THEIR BODIES</u> in HOLINESS and RIGHTEOUSNESS

B. How to be a minister in the New Testament Discipleship Age

These are recommended actions and steps to pursue to become an effective minister of Discipleship to others seeking Discipleship and transformation in JESUS CHRIST.

- 1. You MUST <u>FIRST</u> become a **READER** of the WRITINGS of PAUL and the OTHER APOSTLES of the New Testament
- 2. MUST **READ** the **ENTIRE TEXT** of the **HOLY SCRIPTURES** (helps one to **RIGHTLY** divide the **TRUTH**)





- 3. You MUST TEACH those who have been BORN AGAIN, who are <u>NEWBORN BABE</u>, that they must LOVE and DESIRE the SINCERE MILK of the WORD of GOD that comes through THEIR INDEPENDENT READING and STUDYING of the Holy Scriptures
- 4. You **MUST STUDY** and **UNDERSTAND** the **Seven Frist Principles of GOD**, which are the **Doctrines of JESUS CHRIST**
- You SHOULD be able to answer their questions regarding SALVATION, FASTING, BAPTISM, WALKING, READING, and STUDYING in all of the other Scriptural Patterns of being a follower of Jesus Christ
- 6. You **MUST** <u>help</u> them to **RETURN to the ORIGINAL TERMINOLOGY** of the Holy Scriptures first and foremost, beginning with the fact that they are the Church, a part of the living body of JESUS CHRIST
- 7. You **MUST** <u>have</u> them **UNDERSTAND** that we are **LIVING under a NEW COVENANT** that JESUS CHRIST purchased in His own blood
- 8. You MUST <u>TEACH</u> them to UNDERSTAND that THEY are the TEMPLE of the SPIRIT of God and that THEY are the PRIEST of the TEMPLE of THEIR BODY. THEY who MUST LEARN how to POSSESS their TEMPLE in RIGHTEOUSNESS and HOLINESS so that their BODIES will NOT BE DEFILED
- 9. You MUST <u>TEACH</u> them that the HEART is the SUM of the THOUGHTS of THEIR IMAGINATION and that to KEEP THEIR TEMPLE from BEING DEFILED, they must GET RID of EVIL THOUGHTS and ONLY ALLOW GOOD THOUGHTS
- 10. The **COVID Pandemic** helped people realize they **needed to update their understanding of what the Church was doing to them**. When they were mostly excluded from going into a building or meeting as an organization
- 11. We **MUST** <u>TEACH</u> individuals that **THEY ARE THE CHURCH** and have a **RESPONSIBILITY to WALK with GOD**. THEY MUST LEARN "HOW-TO" do this through the Holy Scriptures so they can do it independently as MATURE FOLLOWERS of JESUS CHRIST according to *Ephesians 4:11-16*
- 12. We **MUST** <u>TEACH</u> individuals the **DEFINITION** of **DISCIPLESHIP** as expressed by Jesus Christ in *St. Matt.* 16:24-28. It declared that if any man comes after Jesus Christ, they must do **three things**; they must **deny themselves**, must **take up their cross**, and they **must follow Jesus Christ!**

13. Summary of Training in this Syllabus

The HOLY GHOST revealed that we had mostly lost the Scriptural Pattern of how to READ and STUDY to become His Disciple! But, unfortunately, I have not found any material that teaches how to READ and STUDY the Holy Scriptures, focusing on INDIVIDUALS as THE CHURCH and DISCIPLES of JESUS!

Therefore, this **Syllabus** was **designed** to provide **Followers of JESUS CHRIST** with a **systematic road map** for studying the writings of the NT Apostles.

JESUS, our SAVIOUR, and RABBI (TEACHER) came to call individuals to become His Pupils (Students, Disciples) so they would STUDY to BECOME LIKE HIM!

Paul encouraged the Gentiles, Kings, and Jews to follow him as He followed JESUS CHRIST!

Paul's extensive writings provide the Scriptures that instructed the early Gentiles in "HOW-TO" WALK with JESUS and to PLEASE the FATHER! (1 Thess 4:1-6, 2 Tim 3:16-17; 2 Pet. 3:14-18)
