Holy Scriptures Analysis of Salvation – Are you Prepared for the LORD's Return?

The purpose of this chart is to provide a Scriptural Analysis of Salvation. The goal is to promote **THOUGHTS** and **CONVERSATIONS** regarding one's Salvation and eternal destination. Salvation is simple, but it can be complicated because of the deceitfulness of man's heart. This chart provides a visual depiction of Salvation based on the Apostles' teachings in the Holy Scriptures. The idea for this chart entered my heart during a discussion with a fellow minister and later with my beautiful wife, Ramona, as I was trying to express the challenges with membership versus Salvation and discipleship in JESUS CHRIST as presented in the Organized Church and Religious Organizations.

The <u>top of the chart</u> shows how all men are born into sin and are in need of **REPENTANCE** and **SALVATION** through **JESUS CHRIST**. The <u>bottom of the chart</u> shows the two eternal destinations: **HEAVEN** and **HELL**. The **chart shows depictions of the characteristics and Scriptures** associated with the various paths that individuals may choose to follow. (St. Matt. 7:13-28) Below is a synopsis of the key information to aid you in understanding which "**PATH YOU ARE ON**!"

THE LORD REVEALED TO ME THE WISDOM THAT THERE ARE THREE BASIC COMPONENTS OF SALVATION:

- 1. CONFESSION What we SAY (OUR WORDS what we say to GOD and others);
- 2. BELIEVE What we BELIEVE (OUR HEART the SUM of the THOUGHTS of our IMAGINATION and OUR FAITH); and
- 3. WALK What we DO (OUR ACTIONS do we WALK with and PLEASE GOD, how do we treat others, and how do we live our daily lives)!

THE HOLY GHOST REVEANED MANKIND EXIBITS FOUR (4) TYPES OF CHARACTERISTICS REGARDING SALVATION. These four characteristics are

best expressed by JESUS's parable about the sower and the seed. Contrary to what many preach today, THE WORD of GOD IS THE SEED! NOT MONEY!

- 1. HARD GROUND GOSPEL of JESUS CHRIST is immediately snatched away by the Devil, Satan.
- 2. SHALLOW GROUND Confesses and believes in JESUS CHRIST for a while but falls away due to tribulation or lust.
- 3. GOOD GROUND (CHOCKED) Truly confesses and believes JESUS CHRIST; drawn away by the cares of this world; walks in darkness (SIN).
- 4. GOOD GROUND (FRUIT) Truly confesses, believes, and walks with JESUS CHRIST (HOLY GHOST); brings forth fruits of righteousness.

SOURCE OF APOSTLES' DOCTRINE GIVEN TO THE NEW TESTAMENT CHURCH (Acts 1:2)

- 1. JESUS called Disciples who were later selected as Apostles. In *St. Matt. 28:18-20*, JESUS commanded His Apostles to go into all the world and (1) preach the Gospel, (2) baptize in the name of the FATHER, SON, and HOLY GHOST, and (3) to **teach them to OBSERVE all things whatsoever He had COMMANDED them**.
- 2. Luke reveals that JESUS "ONLY" sent His Commandments to the NT Church AFTER He had ascended back into Heaven, after His Resurrection. JESUS sent His commandments by His Apostles through the HOLY GHOST. The HOLY GHOST came on the Day of Pentecost. (Act 1:2; 2:1-3)

APOSTLE'S WRITINGS SENT TO TEACH DISCIPLESHIP TO THE NT CHURCH (Acts 1:2)

- 1. Paul, the most prolific writer in the NT, declared how JESUS called and sent him to the NT Church; Gentiles, kings, and the Jews. (Acts 9:15)
 - a. Paul asserts that everything he taught came DIRECTLY FROM JESUS CHRIST (Gal. 1:1-12)
 - b. Paul provided the LORD's commandments covering every aspect of an individual's life and commandments for the LORD's body, the NT Church. (14 letters)
 - c. Paul's writings were also supported by the writings of Peter, James, John, and Jude. (2 Pet. 3:14-18)

ARE YOU PREPARED FOR THE LORD'S RETURN?

- 1. JESUS will judge all men at the final judgment. (St. John 5:25-30)
- 2. Jesus assessed the seven (7) Churches of Asia and commanded most to repent, or they would not be prepared for the final judgment. (Rev. 2-3)
- 3. Jesus will judge all mankind by the Gospel He sent through Paul, the Apostle. (Rom. 2:16, Gal 1:1, 6-12)
- 4. John lists the behavior of those who will not be in Heaven (Rev. 21:8), which agrees with Paul's teachings. (1 Cor. 6:9-20; Gal. 5:19-21)
- 5. JESUS taught how the Kingdom of Heaven is likened unto Ten (10) Virgins, Servants Given Talents, and Sheep and Goats (St. Matt. 25)
- 6. JESUS warned that the way to Heaven was strait and narrow, there would be false prophets, and "not everyone who says LORD, LORD will enter the Kingdom of Heaven. We are required to do the "will of the LORD!" (*St Matt.* 7:13-28)
